



Clinical Trial Process Changes Effective October 1, 2022 (Medicaid)

As of July 1, 2022, providers must submit to Molina a “Medicaid Attestation Form on the Appropriateness of the Qualified Clinical Trial” for every member enrolled in a qualified clinical trial.

- Please submit a separate attestation form for each member enrolled in a clinical trial on or after 7/1/2022. *Only one form per member, per trial is required
- Document “Clinical Trial Attestation Form” on the fax cover sheet

What has not changed? Enrollment in a clinical trial does not require prior authorization (PA). All related services (imaging, etc.) that previously required PA will continue to require PA.

As of 10/1/2022, all coverage determinations related to a qualified clinical trial must be completed within 72 hours of request.

To ensure your authorization requests are processed timely, please include the following with your submission:

- The completed “Medicaid Attestation Form on the Appropriateness of the Qualified Clinical Trial” *If one was not previously submitted.
- Document “Clinical Trial” on the Service Authorization Form in addition to the standard information
- Service Type: Expedited/Urgent*
